Field Trip Expectations

Bus/Van Expectations

- Choose a seat and stay there! You may only move seats IF allowed by Mr. Dwyer.
- Remain in your seats while the bus is moving.
- Follow all adult instructions. This includes Mr. Dwyer, Chaperones, and the bus driver.
- Keep the bus VERY clean. Picking up trash is our responsibility, not the driver's.
- Use low voices or quiet electronics when allowed.
- Turn the flash off if you want to take pictures from the bus – especially at night.
- Show respect to your classmates.
- Eating and drinking may be allowed, but you must clean up after yourselves. Messes means this privilege will get revoked on all buses.

Festival/Workshop Experience

- Be on time. Festivals run tight schedules so follow instructions and stay with your group.
- Be a performer on stage and off. Behavior counts even when you are not on stage.
- Move quietly and in a line from location to location.
- **For Disney Workshop or Forum Festival, carefully follow the instructions of any Host staff adults or student helpers when back stage. DO NOT take pictures, and turn-off your phone while backstage, in a workshop, or preparing to perform.**
- Be polite to staff, other schools, chaperones, and any other adult. 'please,' 'thank you,' and 'great job' goes a long way.

Other Expectations

- Correia School Rules also apply during the trip, see your school planner for Correia Rules
 - Consequences such as detentions, suspensions, and/or expulsion remain in effect
- Be punctual; showing up late for any part of the trip will delay the entire group.
- Demonstrate exceptional behavior and maturity at all times
- Stay close together with our group and your chaperone when instructed to do so.
- Never wander off alone; always have a buddy.
 - Buddies can be anyone from our school group and don't have to be from your chaperone group, but you must remain in groups of 4 or more. If this ever becomes a problem, notify your chaperone immediately or come to the chaperone table area.
- Personal Care
 - Be sure to get a FULL night's sleep. It will be a very long day and you don't want to be tired. Drink water throughout the day but limit at night before the bus ride home.
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 - Advanced, Jazz and Orchestra wear your formal uniform to school in the am and bring a change of clothes for after the festival. This includes your Royal Blue Correia t-shirt.
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 - Beginning Band, Choir, and Guitar wear your Royal Blue Correia Field Trip T-shirt.
 - Correia Dress code otherwise applies. Bring a jacket or small backpack if needed for water bottle and snacks.

Students failing to meet these expectations will be grounded for a pre-determined amount of time at the park. Severe disruptions, such as fighting, stealing, disrespect of an adult chaperone, etc. may result in the immediate dismissal from the trip at the parent's expense.
