Choose a composer of Orchestral or Band music and submit the name to Mr. Dwyer for approval. Writing full and complete paragraphs answer the questions below. Use multiple sources to verify accuracy. Write legibly or type your paper. Make your ideas your own, do not copy and paste (plagiarism is illegal and will be reported to the Correia Administration).

1. Include full name of composer, date of birth and date of death (if applicable).
2. Answer the following questions in your report:
 - Where did they live? Did they move or relocate? Why?
 - Include information about their family. Did their family influence their music and/or compositions?
 - What instruments did they play?
 - When did they begin music lessons? Who did they study with?
 - What major works of music are they best known for?
 - List what type of music they composed (symphonies, concertos, quartets, operas, songs & ballads, toccatas, etudes, cinema/film scores, commercials, etc...)
 - What time in history (or era) did they live?
 - Did this affect their style of music?
 - Did they win awards? If so, what awards or honors did they receive?
 - Is there something about them that you can relate to?
 - Include anything else you find fascinating about this person.
3. Include a list of sources you gathered your information from. Remember use multiple and reliable sources to verify your information. These could include: websites, books, videos, etc.
4. The acceptable length of your paper should be 500-800 words.
