Concert make-up/Extra Credit

Attend a concert and complete an essay including the following information.

1. What concert did you attend? Include date and the name of the group/performer(s). Performances should be in the genres of Jazz, Classical, or a musical. Be sure to see Dwyer for approval BEFORE you attend the performance.
2. Where was the concert performed? Describe in detail (was it outside, in a theater, was it dark, were there chairs, what were the performers wearing, etc.). You need to be specific so that I know you were really there.
3. What were the pieces on the program? Include the titles and composers for EACH piece. If you went to a jazz performance at Anthology, I expect there will be several pieces listed here.
4. Describe (do not just list) the instruments you heard. For example, if you went to a horn ensemble performance, discuss the french horn (origin, what family it's from, what does it look like, sound like, and how is it played. You may need to do a little extra research). Write 75-100 words.
5. Choose THREE pieces to discuss in detail. For each piece, include appropriate information that relates to your class, such as- details about the tempo/tempos (use Italian words where appropriate)- details about the dynamics- details about the form - details about the performance quality/performers themselves. You may need to do some research online about the piece if you feel like you need more substance to your review.
