Field Trip Expectations

Bus/Van Expectations

- Sit in your assigned seats. You may only move seats IF allowed by Mr. Dwyer
- Follow all adult instructions. This includes Mr. Dwyer, Chaperones, and the bus/van driver.
- Keep the bus VERY clean. Picking up trash is our responsibility, not the driver's.
- Use the bathroom only for emergencies.
- Use low voices or quiet electronics when allowed.
- Turn the flash off if you want to take pictures from the bus – especially at night.
- Show respect to your classmates.
- Eating and drinking may be allowed, but you must clean up after yourselves.

Festival Experience

- Be on time. Festivals run tight schedules so follow instructions and stay with your group.
- Be a performer on stage and off. Behavior counts even when you are not on stage.
- Move quietly and in a line from location to location.
- Be polite to staff, other schools, chaperones, and any other adult. 'please,' 'thank you,' and 'great job' goes a long way.

Other Expectations

- Correia School Rules also apply during the trip, see your school planner for Correia Rules
 - Consequences such as detentions, suspensions, and/or expulsion remain in effect
- Be punctual; showing up late for any part of the trip will delay the entire group.
- Demonstrate exceptional behavior and maturity at all times
- Stay close together with our group when instructed to do so (follow me and stay together)
- Never wander off alone; always have a buddy.
 - Buddies don't have to be from your hotel room, but you must remain in groups of 4+
 - If this ever becomes a problem, notify your chaperone immediately.
- Keep yourself healthy:
 - Be sure to get a FULL night's sleep.
 - Eat healthy, avoid junk foods and caffeine
 - Drink plenty of water; carry a water bottle.

Students failing to meet these expectations will be grounded for a pre-determined amount of time at the park. Severe disruptions, such as fighting, stealing, disrespect of an adult chaperone, etc. may result in the immediate dismissal from the trip at the parent's expense.
